# Overview

Heart disease is the leading cause of death for Canadian men and women.

The Mazankowski Alberta Heart Institute has an all-star team of highly skilled cardiologists, cardiovascular surgeons, cardiac care professionals, researchers and educators who are using the latest technology, emerging treatments and innovative approaches with a common goal in mind—to combat all aspects of heart disease through comprehensive cardiac care.

Since the Heart Institute opened in 2009, it has treated an average of 35,000 patients each year. There have been many achievements in complex cardiac care at the Heart Institute. Among those achievements, the Heart Institute is proud to be a leader in echocardiography (echo), having performed over 10,000 cardiac echocardiography tests in 2011.

## THE LEADER IN ECHOCARDIOGRAPHY

As a leading academic institute providing state-of-the-art cardiac care, the Mazankowski Alberta Heart Institute must continue to remain on the forefront of cardiac imaging technology. The Heart Institute was the first in Canada to use 3D echo and houses the largest 3D echo program in North America.

Prior to 3D imaging when an emergency arose, surgery may have been opted in order for the surgeon to fully see the heart, before they could begin repairing the heart. Now physicians utilize echo, enabling them to quickly and easily visualize the complex anatomy of the heart and determine a diagnosis before performing any invasive surgeries. 3D echo also helps to diagnose patients with unexplained disturbances in blood circulation, suspected valve disease or problems with blood clots.

Currently funds are being raised to upgrade the echo cardiograph equipment physicians use to assess patients in the Mazankowski Alberta Heart Institute's echo program. With the support of individuals and organizations in the community the University Hospital Foundation is raising funds to fortify and update this state-of-the-art technology.

- Nine out of ten Canadians have at least one risk factor for heart disease.
- More than 40,000 Canadians experience cardiac arrest each year.
- Over 16,000 Canadians die each year as the result of a heart attack.
- It is estimated that there are 500,000 Canadians living with heart failure and 50,000 new patients are diagnosed each year.
- Heart disease and stroke costs the Canadian economy more than \$20.9 billion every year in physician services, hospital costs, lost wages and decreased productivity.
